**MCA-TV Premieres**  
***Autumn in the Woodlands of the Pittsburgh Botanic Garden Show***

*Moon Township, PA, November 17, 2014* - Tour 60 acres of the new Pittsburgh Botanic Garden in nearby North Fayette Township, when Botanic Garden officials Kitty Vagley, director of development, and Chris Massimino, ethno botanist, explain the history of the former Whiskey Rebellion-era farmland and strip mine, the plantings that have survived over the last three centuries, and the recent efforts to remediate the acid mine drainage there. The new *Autumn in the Woodlands of the Pittsburgh Botanic Garden*, which premieres **Saturday** on MCA-TV, gives glimpses of the Botanic Garden's features, more than a decade in the making. They include Farmstead, its Storybook House in Bookworm Glen, the Margaret Lawrence Simon Dogwood Meadow, and the Botanic Gardens' Woodlands of the World, which include Appalachian, Asian, Cove, Eastern European and English woodlands. The show, produced and directed by Moon resident Sandra F. Donovan, with production assistance MCA-TV volunteer Mary Ann Harcha and production assistants Bryan Chemini and Kendall Valan, gives viewers a chance to see autumnal splendor without leaving their living room.
